Bullion

Gold prices ended with nominal losses as the dollar held firm, although expectations of slower pace of interest rate hikes by the U.S. Federal Reserve limited losses. Producer prices fell the most since April 2020 in December, adding to bets that the Federal Reserve will increase rates by a smaller 25 bps in February.

Energy

Crude oil rose as hopes for a demand recovery in China after its rapid exit from zero-Covid policy outweighed fears of a global economic slowdown. Natural gas dropped on forecasts for warmer weather and less heating demand in late January than previously expected.

Base Metal

Copper prices rose as speculators bet that low inventories and rising Chinese demand will lift prices. Chinese bonded warehouses and warehouses registered with the LME and the COMEX and SHFE contain around 285,000 tonnes of copper, significantly below levels typical before the coronavirus pandemic.
