Bullion

Gold regained betting on firm safe-haven demand as recession risks linger and with expectations of smaller U.S. interest rate hikes. Concerns over a slowdown remain, and this is likely to keep demand for gold, considered a safe store of value during uncertain times, on a firm footing this year.

Energy

Crude oil gains after IEA Executive Director Fatih Birol said that China's economy could be poised for a stronger-than-anticipated rebound that will boost demand for crude. Natural gas remained in range as warmer weather next week is expected to further impact the demand.

Base Metal

Copper fell as demand concerns and a firmer dollar more than offset supply disruptions. Copper inventories in SHFE warehouses jumped by 61.8% since January 20 to 226,509 tonnes on February 3.
