Bullion

Gold prices climbed as a fresh crisis in the banking sector turned investors away from seemingly riskier assets and drove them to the safety of bullion. US PPI report showed that headline and core inflation slowed more than expected in February, opening the door for a possible pause in the Federal Reserve tightening cycle.

Energy

Crude oil extended its slide, as unease over Credit Suisse spooked world markets and offset hopes of a Chinese oil demand recovery. Natural gas dropped as investors monitored forecasts for heating demand and balanced record LNG exports against rising gas output.

Base Metal

Copper prices fell as a stronger dollar dented buying appetite while equities markets were shaken by fresh banking sector concerns. Economic activity in China picked up in the first two months of 2023 as consumption and infrastructure investment drove recovery from pandemic disruption.
